- 1. Oppose Taxpayer Bill of Rights (TABOR) concept as inconsistent with home rule.
- 2. Support strategic lobbying on unfunded mandate issues (i.e. Medicaid and Juvenile Justice increases to Counties).
- 3. Support the creation of Florida Renewable Energy Portfolio Standards (RPS)

We are interested in supporting appropriate septic tank inspections and monitoring the numerous State agency rulemaking initiatives particularly those that affect water quality and environmental regulation.

We are also very supportive of the State's economic incentive programs and encourage any effort to increase the efficiency of distributions of those funds to increase job creation throughout the State of Florida.
