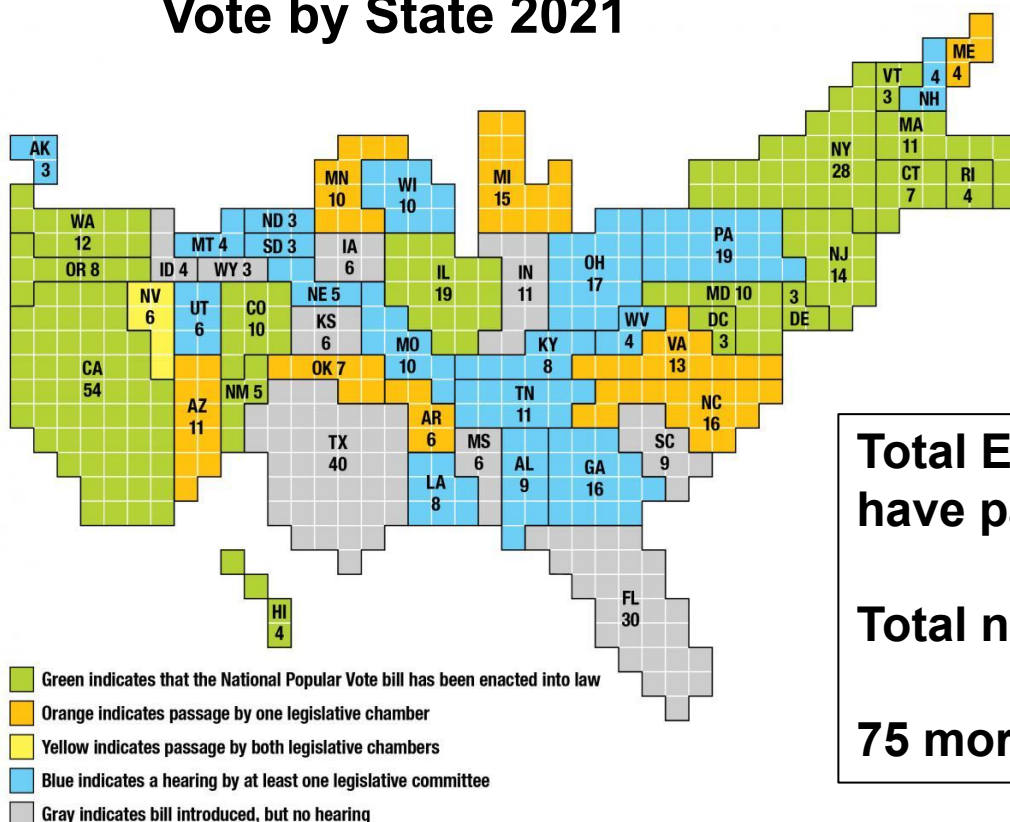


The National Popular Vote bill guarantees the winner in all 50 states becomes president. It preserves the Electoral College and does NOT require a constitutional amendment.

Status of National Popular Vote by State 2021



*What does the US Constitution Say?
 "Each State* shall appoint, in such Manner as the Legislature** thereof may direct, a Number of Electors, equal to the whole Number of Senators and Representatives to which the State may be entitled in the Congress..."*

The US Constitution (Article II, section 1, clause 2)

*State = the 50 states

**Legislature = the elected officials of the state

Total Electoral Votes in states that have passed NPV: 195

Total needed to elect President: 270

75 more Electoral Votes needed

In a National Popular Vote, all votes would be equal.

Currently, Florida's 30 electoral votes each represent 717,933 residents.
These 9 small states with 30 electoral votes each represent 264,592 residents.
A small state's electoral vote is worth nearly 3 times a Floridian's vote!

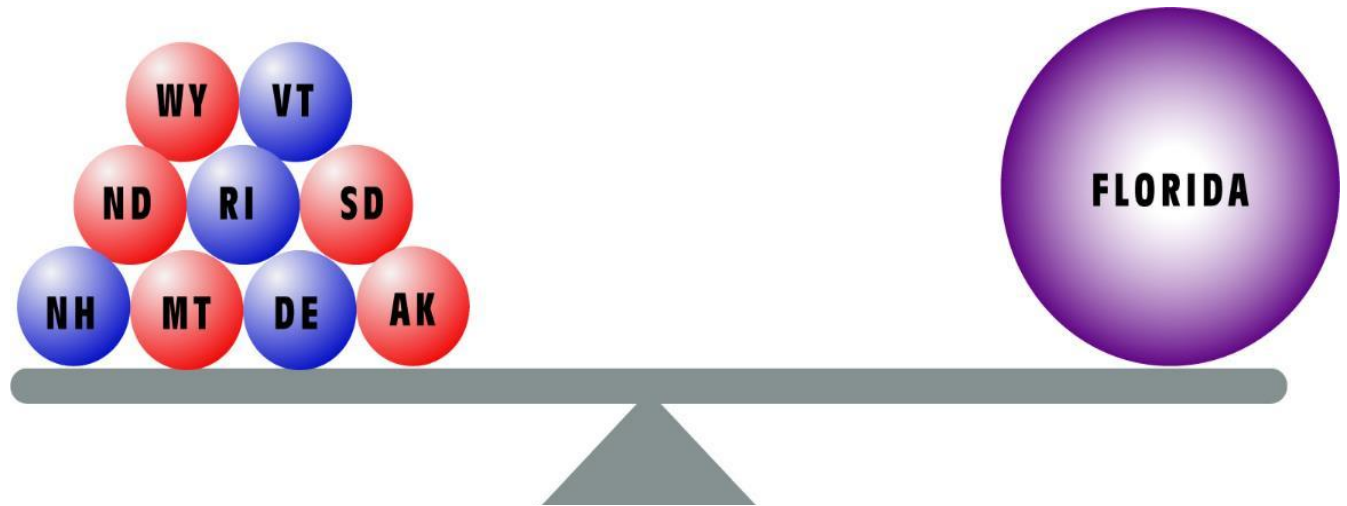
