- Thanks to funding received in 2013, the College is near the average in state funding per Full Time Equivalent for the first time in many years
 - Currently, the student's tuition and fees cover 50.14% of the cost of instruction, versus 47.23% in state support at Edison State

Edison State College supports efforts to address the **Public Education Capital Outlay (PECO)** needs in our state's public education system. Various options have begun to be discussed and we will monitor them as they develop.

We are not advocating for new construction funding, simply the maintenance and repurposing of existing facilities.
